Boxcar Gallery presents *Fracture*, October 28<sup>th</sup> to November 20<sup>th</sup> 2010. This exhibition features the work of Boxcar members Phil Spaulding and Ian Rumley. The opening reception will be Thursday October 28<sup>th</sup> from 6-9pm and First Friday November 5<sup>th</sup> from 6-10pm. *Fracture* will run through November 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

In his new series *Fracture*, Phil Spaulding continues to explore the relationship between the conscious and unconscious mind. His imagery collides creating visual fragments of his memories. These methodically rendered graphite images unite to form a juxtaposition of positive and negative space where imagery becomes the mode of his communication.

Painter Ian Rumley presents *Kill em All*, in which he uses an illustrative style chronicling the history of hatred and violence woven into the human experience. Ian's use of created and appropriated symbolism generates an apocalyptic atmosphere of hopelessness and despair, offering no apologies and suggesting no solutions.
